Dear Minister,

I would like to bring to your attention a situation that it is under consideration by form of a recent letter sent to yourself by our MP Ian Pearson dated the 11th February 05. It is to request your involvement pertaining to a data protection breach that has had fraudulent, corruption, and deception connotations within the complaint. The ombudsman has dealt with the complaint itself but feel the ombudsman's report is of a biased nature supporting the W.P.D and their underhanded way of working. I have accused the department of corruption, fraud, deception and have named individual officers.

My accusations are serious and are true, if this was not the case I would be open to prosecution, however the D.W.P have refrained in doing so because of the deceit in the department that can't be denied. To date the matter has cost me in excess of £8'000 for time, effort and secretarial work. The ombudsman is unable to provide response to the corruption allegations due to being criminal offences. So therefore ask you to suspend the concerned officers for a full and proper inquiry by yourself before the matter is handed over to the media and exposure of the corrupt staff in court proceedings. I am prepared to withhold court proceedings on criminal and civil matters until we have a response from you.
