**Re: Mrs Hossack's Accident Claim**

Further to my recent telephone conversation with Mr Hossack, I enclose for your information a copy of a letter received from Wragge & Co answering the question about the telephone conversation that apparently took place between the Benefits Agency and the Fee Earner who was dealing with the matter at Wragge & Co.

As you will see, they are backtracking somewhat from the positions put in their letter of 7<sup>th</sup> January stating that it was "wrongly phrased".

In the absence of a name, and Wragge & Co now putting a different interpretation on the way in which the information was passed across, I think it makes it even more difficult to pursue any sort of further allegation against the Benefits Agency as they have denied having given any inappropriate information to Wragge & Co.

As it is not an issue that Wragge & Co appear to be pursuing, nor do there appear to be any problems from the DSS, my feeling is that it is perhaps best left.
